enforcement officers


Project Never Broken will continue to honor and celebrate Greg's life and legacy. We will do our best to fill the huge void his absence creates by weaving his essence into everything we do.

Behind the Name

Greg's dad, Mike Ferency, was in the 1st Battalion, 7th Artillery during Vietnam. The unit's motto was Nunquam Fractum, which translates to "Never Broken." The thought process was that if Vietnam didn't break Mike and Greg returned nine shots after being mortally shot, then we will be "never broken" by this evil act.

The three "stitches" between Nunquam and Fractum represent hope, help, and healing as stated in the mission. With that mission in mind, our ultimate goal is for our law enforcement officers and first responders to be never broken.

The "129" on the ag is Greg's badge number. The blue line represents the "thin blue line." Finally, the worn texture of the logo represents Greg's 30 years of service.



July 2022 Afterburner Celebration of Life









In December '22, Project Never Broken brought in Giovanni Rocco to talk about his personal story of being a deep undercover FBI operative for 25+ years. Giovanni shared his own experience with dealing with the stress and trauma that comes with the job.

We hosted two sessions for law enforcement, first responders, military and their significant others. Additionally, we provided copies of Giovanni book, Giovanni's Ring, to each participant.

A public session was also held with the purpose of allowing the public to also get a perspective of the job that may not be as well-known and understood. We were able to connect with 50+ officers from the region, and over 120 members of the public.
